End time – 1600



During the last two days of the conference you will use collected data from the crash tests to solve for impact speeds and delta Vs, and be able to verify if your methodology is correct against the speeds and delta Vs measured by the instrumentation inside the crashed vehicles.

Thursday we will review the crash data collected on the Tuesday crash day, and compare that data, using our traditional reconstruction methods.
